### ST JULIENS PARADE - 27 APR 2019

### SITUATION

1. The 10<sup>th</sup> Battalion Canadian Expeditionary Force participated in a number of battles during World War I. To commemorate our participation in these battles and our fallen each year The Calgary Highlanders conducts a parade to mark the Battle of St Julien's Wood. This year the parade will take place on 27 Apr 2019.

### MISSION

2. The Calgary Highlanders will commemorate the 10<sup>th</sup> Battalion Canadian Expeditionary Forces' service in World War I in a parade to mark the Battle of St Julien Wood on 27 Apr 2019.

### EXECUTION

3. Concept of Operations:

a. Intent: I intent to bring serving member of the regiment together with our veterans and cadet to commemorate the 10<sup>th</sup> Battalion's service in World War I by exercising our freedom of the City of Calgary by marching to a church parade at Knox Church and a commemoration service at the Municipal Building.

b. Scheme of Maneuver:

- (1) Phase I – Preparations: Throughout the month of April a series of parade practices and rehearsals will be conducted.
- (2) Phase II – Parade and Commemoration: The parade will be composed of two guards of service soldiers, the Colours, the old guard and a cadet guard. The parade will depart Mewata Armoury and move to Knox United Church to participate in a Church Parade and Recover the 10<sup>th</sup> Battalion Association Colours. The parade will continue marching to the Municipal Building for a brief commemoration service before returning to Mewata Armoury.

- (3) Phase III – Post Parade Administration: Following the parade there will be an association Annual General Meeting followed by the Reunion Dinner and presentation of Association Trophy's.
  - c. Main Effort: Commemorating the 10<sup>th</sup> Battalion Canadian Expeditionary Force's service in World War I.
  - d. End State: The 10<sup>th</sup> Battalion Association Colours have been moved to the museum for restoration and all members of the regimental family have observed the Battle of St Julien Wood commemorating all the 10<sup>th</sup> Battalion's actions from World War I.
4. Groupings and Tasks. See Annex B and Annex C.
5. Coordinating Instructions:
- a. Timings. A detailed master events list can be found at Annex D General timings are:
    - (1) 0900 hrs – all pers arrive in combats and draw weapons and whites;
    - (2) 0900-1100 hrs: Rehearsals
    - (3) 1100-1200 hrs – Lunch and change
    - (4) 1200-1615 hrs - Parade;
    - (5) 1700-1800 hrs – Association AGM; and
    - (6) 1800-2030 hrs: Regimental Association Dinner and Trophies.
  - b. Dress: Orders of dress are as follows:
    - (1) All members on parade, including the Pipes and Drums, will wear No. 1 order of dress with white gloves and belts;
    - (2) All members not issued DEU's will wear CADPAT with Glengarry with white gloves and belts.
  - c. Parade Format. Conduct of the parade is outlined in Annex A and the Church service is outlined in Annex A - Appendix 1.
  - d. Reviewing Officer / Dignitaries. TBC
  - e. Public Affairs: UPAR will coordinate media releases, social media, and imagery requirements.
  - f. Weapons requirements. Weapons will be carried as follows
    - (1) CO, DCO, Guard Commanders: Dirks with Swords;

- (2) Subordinate Officers: Swords;
- (3) RSM and Guard Sergeant Majors: Pace Sticks;
- (4) All other NCMs on Parade: C7A2 with Bayonets;
- (5) Cadets: Lee Enfield Rifles.
